

### EASTWARD FREIGHT STEAM TRAINS

Following the SP practice, there will be two long Freight Trains from Gerber to Dunsmuir South Yard.

### Here the two trains will be split into three trains East.

Siskiyou traffic will be split out and the remaining two East Bound to K-Falls will be Blocked according to the stops along the way, fist city/town will be at the head end. and so forth. The Blocking list is posted at DUSY (Dunsmuir South Yard).

Here head-end steam power will be Changed to Mountain Div. power and the Valley Div. caboose will be replaced with a Mountain caboose.

If the Valley Train has Steam Power, the Valley Power will be sent to DUNY (Dunsmuir North Yard) for service.

In every case (Except Pig Trains with a Silver Caboose), the Valley Cabooses will be sent to DUNY to be turned on the turntable.

Once Turned it will be returned to the Caboose Track in DUSY.

The DUSY YM will place a Mountain Caboose (with under back-deck inspection lamps).

The DUNY Hostler, under direction of the DUNY Yard Master, will have prepared the Mountain Power to go up the Hill.

These Steam locos will be Double headed and backed down the River Track to connect to the Waiting Freight, according to the time table.

### All Freight Crew Changes are at DUSY.

When a train is ready, the South Yard Master will call the Crew Dispatcher for a crew.

Crew Paperwork will be provided by the Crew Dispatchers office, on the first floor.

The Crew Conductor will annotate the Work Orders, as to his Name, Engine Numbers and Caboose number. At the end of the trip, the Crew will return all paper work to the Crew Dispatcher's office - on the first floor.

### WESTWARD TRAINS

All Westward Freight trains will also change crews in the South Yard and Mountain Equipment exchanged for Valley Equipment.

Steam Power will be returned to DUNY for servicing and then Turned and held in the power pool at DUNY for the next Eastward Train.

Cabooses will be returned to DUNY to be turned and returned to the DUSY YM for placement on the Caboose Ready Track.

### AS always, YOUR ASSISTANCE IS APPRECIATED:

- 1. Any anomaly as to *missing cars* or Bad-Order cars shall be so annotated, Name and Car #, on the Paper work and also the location where any such car was left behind.
- 2. Any missing cars listed on your paperwork shall be so indicated.
- 3. Any tracking issues shall be noted as to details and location, so the MOW crew can repair. This has always been very helpful, in the past.

I hope this will now keep the Yard Masters Busy and we can all have an enjoyable session.







Soldering iron, min 35 watts.


